- 8. Communicate in writing, at the church business meeting, details of your personal ministry activities; including, but not limited to, visits, contacts (phone calls, emails, texts, cards, etc.), attendance at student events (graduations, sporting events, etc.), community events, and other ministry activities.
- 9. Communicate the activities of the Youth Ministry to the Pastor and Church Administrator for informational purposes, as well as advertising.
- 10. Recruit, develop, and empower volunteer teams of committed leaders to engage in the youth ministry and actively disciple students.
- 11. Actively participate in the overall ministry of the church; including but not limited to, worship services, Vacation Bible School, community outreach events, and special services.
- 12. Effectively work to build relationships with parents and guardians of the youth.
- 13. Consistently maintain outreach efforts targeting youth in the community.
- 14. Prepare, maintain, and implement all budgetary matters related to the youth ministry.
